

PREPARING MASTER WITH A DIGITAL FILE (1- and 2-colours) :

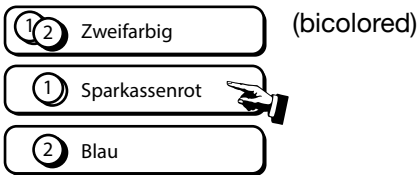
If you want to print a multiple colored file, that's how it goes:



Starten with this button:

--> If the RISO is asking: Delete current job? --> press OK
(Aktueller Job löschen? --> OK)

Now these options appear on the screen:



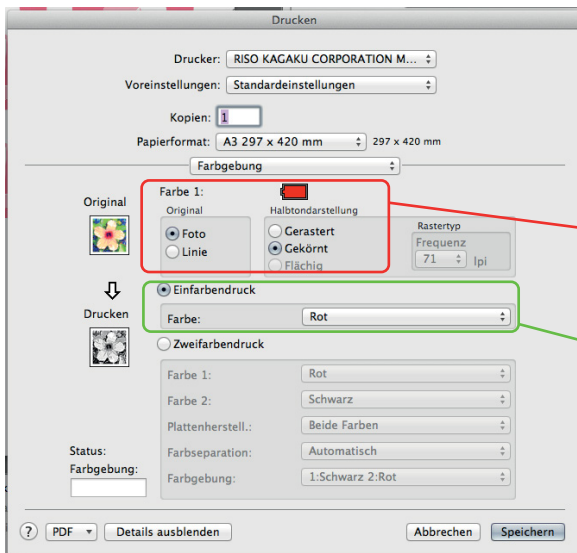
Chose Colour 1. Start with the LEFT Drum.

--> **Masterher.** (prepare Master)

Go to computer: Open your file (Photoshop, Illustrator)

Hide all Layers which are not the color for this Master

Send to Printer (RISO): $\text{⌘} + P$ (Datei --> Drucken)



This operator panel appears:

Druckeinstellungen --> Farbgebung Printsettings

Printsettings: Foto/Linie - gekörnt etc.

Einfarbindruck anwählen Chose one colour print

IMPORTANT: Chose the right colour here!

It's better to prepare your screen/raster in previously in Photoshop (more options).

Now you can send your file for the first color to the RISO and your first Master will be prepared.

On the bottom left corner of the RISO Screen appears Pause, click on it and release the process of the Master preparation manually:



FOR THE SECOND COLOUR:

For the second Master on your RIGHT DRUM, there are some IMPORTANT NEWS!



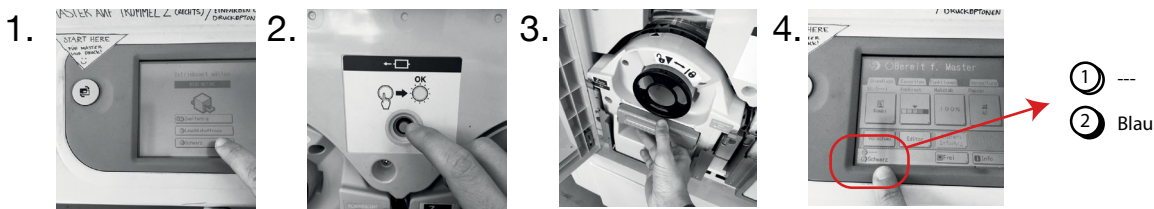
Again start with this button

---> If the RISO is asking: Delete current job? --> press OK
(Aktueller Job löschen? --> OK)

Chose colour Nr.2 on the screen --> **Masterher.**



NOW: Open the front Cover of the RISO, unlock the drums (2.) and pull the LEFT DRUM a little bit out (3.) so it is unlocked but you can still close the frontcover! On the homescreen, bottom left corner, it should look like this (4.) Through this we can prevent that our first Master (1.Colour) is pulled off the drum again - aka thrown in the bin.



Now you can send your file for the second color to the RISO make sure all other color layers are hidden in your file.

The red drum normaly has troubles, just press, FORTSETZEN

--> Press Save (Speichern) and Print (Drucken)

PRINT WITH 2-COLOURS:



Start again with this button on the RISO.

This time chose ZWEIFARBIG (bicoloured) --> **Drucken**

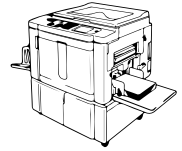
Now you can work with both drums at the same time and print bicoloured.

IMPORTANT: Chose the order which colour should be printed first.

Left drum will be printed first on your paper (below).

You can switch the drums the way you want it.

PREPAING MASTER WITH A ANALOGEN FILE drawing, sketchbook (1- and colours):



Put your colour drum of choice in the LEFT position
Remember: We ONLY do masters on the LEFT drum!!



Press this button
---> If the RISO is asking: Delete current job? --> press OK

Chose your colour, nr.1 and --> **Masterher.**

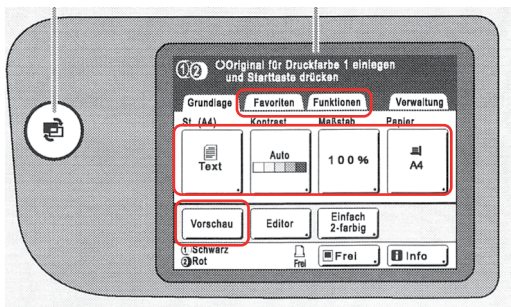
Now put your analog template (drawing, sketchbook, foto... or similar) below the top loader - BELOW THE FOIL!!

Also put a cospaper in the slot of the RISO (for an automatic testprint)

Before you start preparing the master chose all settings at the RISO:

All these options are here:



Now start the SCANN with the turquoise START-button.

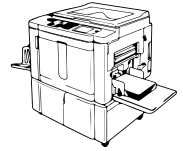
If there is a defect note „ Original kann nicht erkannt werden“ Original can't be recognized check if you forgot to put your template under the toploder, then press Fortsetzen.

After the scann you'll see the preview on the RISO screen, if your happy with it press:
--> Fortsetzen

Now your master is prepared and a test print will follow!

For the second colour repeat the whole process, but don't forget to switch the drums!!

ADJUSTING COLOURS FOR MULTIPLE COLOURED PRINTS:

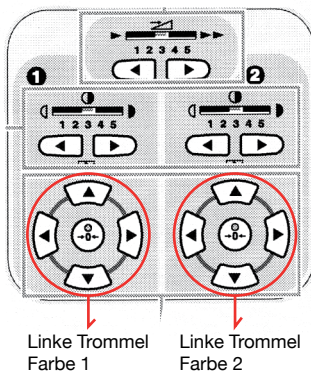


If we print multiple colour projects, we need to adjust the colours on to each other for a precise outcome (if wished).

First always print a bicoloured testprint.

---> The testprint while preparing the masters are NO reference!

Please remember which direction the print came out of the RISO.



With these arrows, you can adjust the prints (not the paper!) you can separately move the two colours to the left, right, up or down to adjust the colours with each other.

Until you adjusted the two colours the way you want it, use copypaper. Just when everything is ready, print your edition on your nice paper.

Projects with more than 2 colours:

1. start with adjusting the first two colours
2. print 3-5 extra prints on copypaper* (for 3 or more coloured projects)
3. print your edition on your nice paper

--> 4 coloured projects:

4. switch the drums to colour 3 (left) and 4 (right)
adjust colour Nr.3 and 4 to each other like you did it with colour Nr.1 and 2.
5. *with your extra prints, adjust colour 3 and 4 on to colour 1 and 2
6. when this is ready: print your edition!
7. Enjoy your finished RISO prints! 😊

--> Printing a double sided Project:

always make a few extraprints, to adjust the backside easier on the the frontside.
